Day 1 (22.01.2024)

On the inaugural day 22.01.2024 NSS volunteers reached the site and started their day with yoga exercises. Necessary information was share with the volunteers and site was decorated for the inaugural programme. In this programme started around 10.30 am in which Ms. Sofiya, Assistant Professor, English and Ms. Neeraj, Assistant Professor, Geography both from Maharani Kishori Jat Kanaya Mahavidyalaya, Rohtak were the Chief Guests.
